Hurricane season begins June 1 and ends November 30.

STORM SERVICES

GENERATOR TIPS AND INFORMATION

The Housing Department will top off generators prior to a storm as well as test and repair on a quarterly basis.

- Do not use generators indoors.
- Do not operate a generator while unattended.
- Keep your home well-ventilated and install carbon monoxide detectors.
- Use the proper fuel while operating and keep the generator dry.
- Operate the generator on dry surfaces, with dry hands.
- Power down the generator and allow it to cool before re-fueling.

DEBRIS MANAGEMENT

Public Works Department Debris Pickup during hurricane season:

- **Hollywood, Big Cypress, Brighton, Fort Pierce & Immokalee: Wednesdays**
- **Lakeland: Utilize Solid Waste On-Site Dumpster**

SHUTTERS

If assistance is required installing shutters, contact your reservation housing office.

SPECIAL MEDICAL NEEDS

Those who have special medical needs should schedule a clinic visit to be assessed by a medical provider.

The Health Department will check on all special medical needs patients prior to and after a storm, as soon as conditions are safe.



**LIGHTNING
DETECTION ALERTS**

Horns operate daily from
7:00 A.M. - 11:00 P.M.

WHEN TO SEEK SHELTER:
Horns will alert with a 15 second blast and strobe light flashes when lightning is detected in the area.

ALL CLEAR SIGNAL:
Horns will alert with 3 short blasts.
